NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration in an accredited post-secondary institution.

Purpose: To provide scholarships to four to six (4-6) deserving Key Club Members, who have demonstrated outstanding Community Service and Academic Achievement, intending to pursue higher education.

Award Components: Scholarships in the amount of \$500 or \$1000 and individual certificates will be awarded to four to six (4-6) students selected by the Kiwanis of Chatsworth Foundation Scholarship Committee.

Criteria:

1. Applicants must be active Key Club members at a high school sponsored by Kiwanis of Chatsworth.
2. Applicant must be a senior in the year of the award.
3. Applicant's GPA must be 3.0 or higher (on a 4.0 scale)
4. Applicant must intend on pursuing higher education, within the United States, immediately following graduation from high school.
5. Applicant must volunteer a minimum of 50 hours of Community Service between April 2025 and March 2026
6. Applicant must submit required essay(s) and/or video.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

1. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly)
2. An official recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average.
3. Completed Community Service Tracking Sheet documenting a minimum of 30 hours of Community Service completed between April 2025 and March 2026.
4. Community Service Essay: Must be typed and between 500 and 1,000 words.

TOPIC: Tell us a specific story how Community Service has made an impact on your life...

5. Personal Essay or Video: Essay must be typed and between 500 and 1,000 words. Video must be between 1.5 – 3.0 minutes long and submitted via CD, DVD, or Flash Drive. (Media will not be returned.)

TOPIC: Tell us about who you are...
